THIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This weekend we continue our mini sermon series for Holy Week, *Come and See*, following Jesus' journey from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday. On Good Friday, we remember that Christ, our promised king, died for the sins of the world. In the silence of the crucifixion, we respond in hope to the song from Ephesians, "wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you" (Ephesians 5:14). Easter Sunday is a celebration of Christ's victory—the king is risen—which transforms how we relate to God and the world in new life. One of the resurrection accounts in the Gospel of Mark leaves us with a powerful question: *how will we live in response to the resurrection?* On Sunday, we behold the good news about Jesus together and consider our response.

The message this Sunday will focus on Mark 16:1-8, "Come and See: The Risen King"

Easter Sunday we anticipate the baptisms of Anya Masih at the 9:00 a.m. service, and Dennis Groves-Blanchard at the 11:00 a.m. service. We praise God for this expression of their faith!

COMMEMORATION OF THE 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LIBERATION OF THE NETHERLANDS: May 2025 marks the 80th Anniversary of the Liberation of the Netherlands. To commemorate this historic and most significant event in Dutch history (and the personal history of so many immigrants and their descendants), the Canadian Military and the Dutch Community will honour this significant milestone with a planned commemoration that will take place on Sunday, May 4th. It will be preceded by a Church Service at 10:30 am at Holy Trinity Anglican, followed by a short march/walk to South Alberta Light Horse Park in Old Strathcona where the actual ceremony will take place. The 80th anniversary, as a major commemoration, will be the last time actual living soldiers who were part of the Canadian army, will be in attendance. The few that are left are now 100 years of age or older. Also, those who were liberated are now in their late 80's or in their 90s. Thus, it will close a chapter of living history. Please consider attending.
