ITHIS WEEK'S SERVICE

This Sunday we continue the season of Advent with our sermon series, *God Comes Close*, reflecting on this week's theme of love. We heard the angel's announcement to Mary and to the shepherds – have you ever wondered how Joseph heard the news? God sent an angel to Joseph to reveal that Mary's pregnancy was from the Holy Spirit. This child, Jesus, and his life would bring about everything Joseph longed for – God to save us from our sins. The message this Sunday will focus on Matthew 1:18-24, "Love in the Unknown."

CHRISTMAS EVE SERVICES: We are excited as we work hard to prepare a meaningful and impactful Christmas Eve Service - a service which is so important to our community!

Come with us as we step into the Christmas story, at 4:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. Jesus Christ came to us as God's promised anointed one, the son of God who would save the world. At his birth, we remember him as our Prophet and Teacher, Priest, Shepherd, King, and Savior. What role does Jesus play for you?
